To schedule a practice round on October 2, please call the Golf Shop, (859) 236-2838, after September 5 between 8 AM and 5 PM.

Additional practice rounds may be scheduled; the fee will be \$52.00 (weekend), \$42.00 (week days)

The Danville Country Club features a challenging, beautifully maintained 18 hole, par 72 golf course with Bermuda fairways and bent grass greens. The gentle rolling terrain, wide fairways, and strategically placed bunkers provide all skill levels a wonderful experience.

The course has been home to key tournaments throughout its history, including the Kentucky State Amateur as well as Senior Professional Golf exhibitions and local annual tournaments such as the Tee Cup for Ladies.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who (1) were female at birth (2) will have reached their 50th birthday by October 3, and (3) have up-to-date USGA Handicap Indexes not exceeding 23.5 under the USGA Handicap System.

Contestants must also be a member of a club or women's golf organization in one of the fifteen southern states or the District of Columbia. The club must be a 2006 member of Women's Southern Golf Association.

All entries are subject to the approval of both the WSGA Championship Committee and Host Club. Appropriate golf attire **must** be worn; shorts must not be shorter than 5 inches above the top of the knee. Golf shoes must have soft-spikes.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

The entry fee is \$225 and includes one practice round and three rounds of golf, all cart fees, practice balls, club storage, gratuities and social events.

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$55.

Entries close **September 1 at 5 PM**. Entrants who cancel **prior to September 15 at 5 PM** will be refunded the entry fee less a \$15 administrative fee. **No** refunds will be given to those who cancel after **September 15 at 5 PM**.

The field will be limited to 112 players. The lowest 32 Handicap Indexes and ties will be accepted when the application is received by September 1. The remainder of entries will be accepted in the order of receipt. Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be mailed September 5.

Entries will be accepted after the closing date if the field is not full and the Committee decides to extend the closing date. Entries received after the field is full will be placed on the waiting list.

FORMAT

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and consists of 54 holes of stroke play.

Flights will be determined by 36 hole score. Awards will be presented in all flights.

TROPHIES

Katherine Graham Senior Trophy will be awarded to the Champion.

The *Super Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the contestant who has reached her 70th birthday by October 3 and has the lowest 54 hole gross score.
