PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice Round times will be available beginning May 29. If more than one practice round is desired, the fee will be \$40 and includes cart.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers: 1) female at birth; 2) have a handicap index not exceeding 18.4 under the USGA Handicap System, and 3) a member of a club, women's golf organization or a college student attending a school in one of the fifteen southern states or the District of Columbia. Membership dues must be paid to Women's Southern Golf Association for 2007.

All entries are subject to the approval of both the WSGA Tournament Committee and Host Club. Appropriate golf attire **must** be worn. Golf shoes must have soft-spikes.

WSGA reserves the right to use all photographs taken during the tournament on the WSGA website and in press and promotional releases.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

The entry fee is \$230 and includes one practice round, the qualifying round and two rounds of match play with carts, practice balls, gratuities and social events. Cart fees for Thursday and Friday matches are \$20 and must be paid in the Golf Shop. Cart fees are mandatory.

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$70.

The entry fee will be refunded if requested by 5 PM (EST) Friday, May 25. A \$15 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds. **No refunds for cancellations after May 25.** Non-refunded entry fees will go to the WSGA Scholarship Fund.

The field will be limited to 128 players and the Committee reserves the right to limit the field size. Players with the lowest 48 Handicap Indexes and ties will be accepted when the application is received by Friday, May 4. The remainder of the entries will be accepted in the order of receipt. Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be mailed May 7.

Entry Deadline: Friday, May 4, 5:00 PM (EST) The Committee reserves the right to extend the deadline if the field is not full. Entries received after the field is full will be placed on the waiting list.

RULES OF PLAY

All competition will be played in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf.

The low 32 qualifiers will constitute Championship Flight. Any ties for last place in the Championship Flight will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off held immediately following the Qualifying Round. Any player tied and not present at the time of the play-off will forfeit her right to play in the Championship Flight and will be paired in the First Flight.

Championship Flight players must walk and will have assigned cart drivers/caddies. After the first round of match play, contestants in Championship Consolation Flight will use carts.

All other flights will be composed of 16 players who use carts. Ties for 16th place in these flights will be determined by the order in which the scorecards are returned.

Final matches will play 18 holes. The Championship Flight will play 36 holes.

WSGA reserves the right to determine if the last flight will be at Match or Stroke Play.

It is the responsibility of all players to continue in Match Play after qualifying. Withdrawals will be referred to the Championship Decisions Committee.

TROPHIES

LOW NET TROPHY- The annual Riely Eakin Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the contestant having the lowest net qualifying score.

SENIOR MEDALIST- The Marguerite Gaut perpetual cup will be awarded to the contestant 50 years of age or older having the lowest qualifying score.

JUNIOR MEDALIST- The Marty Webb perpetual cup will be awarded to the contestant who has not reached her 18th birthday before the end of the Championship and who has the lowest qualifying score.

TEAM TROPHY- The lowest combined qualifying scores of any two competitors from the same club will determine the winners of the perpetual Team Trophy.
