Additional practice rounds may be scheduled; the fee will be \$40.00.

#### **General Information**

Appropriate golf attire **must** be worn; shorts must not be shorter than 5 inches above the top of the knee. Golf shoes must have soft-spikes. Denim attire **is not allowed** on the premises.

WSGA reserves the right to use all photographs taken during the tournament on the WSGA website and in press and promotional releases.

The Plantation Course, designed by Bob Cupp, was built in 1989 as the second of two championship courses at Woodside Plantation Country Club. The course was carefully designed to provide a challenge to all skill levels while maintaining the rolling, wooded terrain of the entire property. Locally referred to as the “Cupp Course”, players will notice ample driving areas, subtle breaks and few forced carries to provide the appearance of a user friendly course while maximizing enjoyment at all levels.

## ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who (1) were female at birth (2) will have reached their 50<sup>th</sup> birthday by October 29, and (3) have a current USGA Handicap Index not exceeding 23.5 under the USGA Handicap System.

Contestants must also be a member of a club or women’s golf organization in one of the fifteen southern states or the District of Columbia. The club must be a 2007 member of Women’s Southern Golf Association.

All entries are subject to the approval of both the WSGA Championship Committee and Host Club.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

The entry fee is \$215 and includes one practice round and three rounds of golf, all cart fees, practice balls, club storage, gratuities and social events.

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$55.

Entries close **September 28 at 5 PM**. Entrants who cancel **prior to October 12 at 5 PM** will be refunded the entry fee less a \$20 administrative fee (includes a \$5 fee for the Scholarship Fund). **No** refunds will be given to those who cancel after **October 12 at 5 PM**.

The field will be limited to 112 players. The lowest 32 Handicap Indexes and ties will be accepted when the application is received by September 28. The remainder of entries will be accepted in the order of receipt. Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be mailed October 3.

Entries will be accepted after the closing date if the field is not full and the Committee decides to extend the closing date. Entries received after the field is full will be placed on the waiting list.

## FORMAT

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and consists of 54 holes of stroke play.

Flights will be determined by 36 hole score. Awards will be presented in all flights.

## TROPHIES

*Katherine Graham Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the Champion.

The *Super Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the contestant who has reached her 70<sup>th</sup> birthday by October 29 and has the lowest 54 hole gross score.
