Additional practice rounds may be scheduled on Saturday, October 23 after 1 PM or Sunday, October 24 before noon. The fee will be \$70 (inclusive).

General Information

Appropriate golf attire **must** be worn; shorts **must not** measure more than 5 inches above the middle of the kneecap. Golf shoes must have soft-spikes. Denim attire **is not allowed** on the premises.

Texarkana Country Club

Texarkana CC began in 1914 with a nine-hole golf course with sand greens. The prestigious architectural firm of Langford and Moreau from Chicago designed the current course in 1922. Mr. Langford is best known for his style of deep bunkers and sloping greens. A renovation was done in 2000, but it still retains the flavor of its original design. Highlights of the

course include gentle and subtle elevation changes, a beautiful lake on the front nine, meandering creeks on the back nine, tree lined fairways and abundant sand and grass bunkers. Golfing legend Byron Nelson served as Club Pro in 1934 prior to his outstanding career on the PGA Tour. Don Murphy then served for 41 years and was inducted into the Arkansas Golf Hall of Fame.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry into the WSGA Senior Championship is open to amateur golfers who are female at birth, have reached their fiftieth birthday by October 26, have a USGA Handicap Index not exceeding 23.5; and who are members of the WSGA through a WSGA member golf club or women's golf organization. Golf clubs or women's golf organizations in the fifteen southern states or the District of Columbia are eligible to join WSGA. All contestants must have a Handicap Index computed under the USGA Handicap System and must be issued from a "golf club" which is licensed to the USGA Handicap System.

Membership must be current as of the entry closing.

A contestant may remit dues for her club.

All entries are subject to the approval of both the WSGA Championship Committee and Host Club.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

The entry fee is \$290 and includes one practice round and three rounds of golf, all cart fees, practice balls, club storage, gratuities and social events.

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$70.

Entries are available on line for additional \$5.00 fee.

Entries close **October 1 at 5 PM CDT**. Contestants who cancel **prior to October 15 at 5 PM CDT** will be refunded the entry fee less a \$25 administrative fee. (includes a \$5 fee for the Scholarship Fund).

No refunds will be given to those who cancel after **October 15 at 5 PM CDT**.

The field will be limited to 112 players. The low 56 Handicap Index players and ties will be accepted if the application is received by October 1. The remainder of

entries will be accepted by order of receipt. If entry applications exceed 112 on October 1, a wait list will be established according to Handicap Index. Entries received after the closing date will be added to the wait list in order of entry receipt.

Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be mailed October 4.

Entries will be accepted after the closing date if the field is not full.

FORMAT

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and consists of 54 holes of stroke play.

Flights will be determined by 36 hole score.

Awards will be presented in all flights.

TROPHIES

Katherine Graham Senior Trophy will be awarded to the Champion.

The *Super Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the contestant who has reached her 70th birthday by October 26 and has the lowest 54 hole gross score.
