PRACTICE ROUNDS

A practice round included in your entry fee may be played June 11. Tee times may be scheduled May 1 or after. Call the Pro Shop at 501-922-3095. Additional practice rounds for players will be available at a cost of \$49.00+tax (am), \$45.00+tax (pm). Guests are allowed to play during the additional practice round only. Guest fees are \$89.00+tax (am), \$75.00+tax (pm). Guests are not allowed to play on June 11.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry into the WSGA Amateur/Mid-Amateur Championships is open to female amateur golfers who have a USGA Handicap Index not exceeding 18.4 and who are members of the WSGA through a WSGA member golf club, women's golf organization, or a college/university in one of the fifteen southern states or the District of Columbia. Dues may be paid by an individual. All players must have a Handicap Index computed under the USGA Handicap System and must be issued from a "golf club" which is licensed to the USGA Handicap System. Membership must be current as of the entry closing.

All players who have not reached age 25 as of June 12, 2017 **must** compete in the Amateur Championship. Players age 25 and above as of June 12, 2017 may compete in either the Amateur or the Mid-Amateur Championship and must indicate on their entry form in which Championship they plan to compete.

All entries are subject to the approval of both the WSGA Tournament Committee and Host Club. Appropriate golf attire **must** be worn. Golf shoes must have soft-spikes.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

The entry fee is \$275.00 and includes one practice round, the qualifying round and two rounds of match play with carts, practice balls, club gratuities, and social events. Cart fees for Thursday and Friday matches are \$35.00 + tax per player and must be paid in the Golf Shop. **CART FEES ARE MANDATORY. PLAYERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CARRY THEIR GOLF BAGS.**

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$75.

The entry fee will be refunded if requested by 5:00 PM (CDT) Sunday, May 28. A \$25 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds. **No refunds will be given to those who cancel after May 28 at 5 pm CDT, NO EXCEPTIONS**, other than NCAA obligations.

The field will be limited to 48 Amateur players and 48 Mid-Amateur players, and the Committee reserves the right to limit the field size. Players with the lowest 48 Handicap Indexes in each championship will be accepted when the application is received by Friday, May 12. If entries exceed the limit on May 12, a Wait List will be established according to Handicap Index. If an entry is received after May 12, it will be added to the end of the wait list of players who submitted their entry prior to May 12. Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be emailed May 13.

Entry Deadline: Friday, May 12, 5:00 PM (CDT) The Committee reserves the right to extend the deadline if the field is not full. The Committee also reserves the right to adjust the number of players in each Championship and flight based on the number of entries received for each Championship.

RULES OF PLAY

All competition will be played in accordance with the current USGA Rules of Golf. **The Local Rule allowing use of distance measuring devices will be in effect.**

The low 32 Amateur qualifiers will constitute the Amateur Championship Flight. Any ties for last place in the Amateur Championship Flight will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off held immediately after the Mid-Amateur qualifiers have teed off for their Qualifying Round. Any player tied and not present at the time of the play-off will forfeit her right to play in the Amateur Championship Flight and will be paired in the First Flight.

The low 32 Mid-Amateur qualifiers will constitute the Mid-Amateur Championship Flight. Any ties for last place in the Mid-Amateur Championship Flight will be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off held immediately after the Mid-Amateur qualifiers have completed their Qualifying Round. Any player tied and not present at the time of the play-off will forfeit her right to play in the Mid-Amateur Championship Flight and will be paired in the First Flight.

All contestants must use carts in the Qualifying Round.

During match play, Amateur Championship Flight players must walk and will have assigned cart drivers/caddies. No personal caddies will be allowed. After the first round of match play, contestants in Amateur Championship Consolation Flight will use carts.

All other flights in the Amateur/Mid-Amateur Championships will be composed of 16 players who must use carts. Ties for 16th place in these flights will be determined by the order in which the scorecards are returned.

The yardages for the Amateur Championship will be approximately 6,100 yards and approximately 5,600 yards for the Mid-Amateur Championship. These are estimates and are subject to change.

The final match in the Amateur Championship Flight will be an 18 hole match as will all other matches in both the Amateur and Mid-Amateur Flights.

It is the responsibility of all players to continue in Match Play (**including consolation**) after qualifying. Withdrawals will be referred to the Championship Decisions Committee.

SPECIAL AWARDS

AMATEUR MEDALIST - The Evelyn Monsted perpetual trophy will be awarded to the contestant in the Amateur Championship having the lowest qualifying score.

JUNIOR MEDALIST - The Marty Webb perpetual trophy will be awarded to the contestant in the Amateur Championship who has not reached her 18th birthday before the end of the Championship and who has the lowest qualifying score.

MID-AMATEUR MEDALIST- The Marcia Mileti perpetual trophy will be awarded to the player having the lowest qualifying score in the Mid-Amateur Championship.
