Sam Snead launched his career on this fabled Virginia mountain golf course, which has the honor of being ranked among "America's 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses" by Golf Digest.

Designed by legendary course architect William S. Flynn, The Cascades uses its varied terrain to influence play, rather than dictate it.

## ELIGIBILITY

Entry into the WSGA Senior Championship is open to amateur female golfers who have reached their fiftieth birthday by September 19, have a USGA Handicap Index not exceeding 23.5 and who are members of the WSGA through a WSGA member golf club or women's golf organization. Golf clubs or women's golf organizations in the fifteen southern states and the District of Columbia are eligible to join WSGA. All contestants must have a handicap index computed under a USGA Handicap System and must be issued from a "golf club" which is licensed to the USGA Handicap System. Membership must be current as of the entry closing. A contestant may remit dues for her club.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

Entries can be mailed or completed online at:

[www.womens-southerngolfassociation.org](http://www.womens-southerngolfassociation.org).  
The entry fee is \$280.00 and includes one practice round and three rounds of golf, all cart fees, practice balls, gratuities and social events.

The fee for WSGA Non-playing Officials is \$80.00.

Entries close **August 18 at 5 PM CDT**. Contestants who cancel **prior to September 5 at 5 PM CDT** will be refunded the entry fee less a \$25 administrative fee.

**No** refunds will be given to those who cancel after **September 5 at 5 PM CDT – no exceptions.**

The field will be limited to 112 players and all entries will be accepted by order of receipt. If entry applications exceed 112 on August 18, a wait list will be established according to date of entry. Notification of acceptance or placement on the waiting list will be emailed on August 19. Entries will be accepted after the closing date if the field is not full.

## FORMAT

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and consist of 54 holes of stroke play.

There will be 2 sets of tees (approximately 5500 & 5100 yards). The low 32 handicap index players will play from the longer yardage and form Championship and First Flight. All other players will play from the shorter yardage to form all other flights.

Flights will be determined by 36 hole scores.

Awards will be presented in all flights.

## TROPHIES

*Katherine Graham Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the Champion.

The *Super Senior Trophy* will be awarded to the contestant who has reached her 70<sup>th</sup> birthday by September 19 and has the lowest 54 hole gross score.
